Along the route to Tennessee we toured the Luther Prep School in Watertown, WI and Wisconsin Lutheran College in Milwaukee, WI as well as the Creation Museum in Kentucky. The rally’s theme was “Fill Up,” focusing on filling up with God’s Word, his love, and forgiveness. The rally consisted of keynote presentations, workshops, recreation and entertainment. “Flying By Air,” a musical comedy juggling act, and “Chapter 6,” an a cappella group, were hits among the rally goers.
