BWCA TRIP: The youth group would like to thank everyone who supports them by using the gift cards. Two-thirds of their trip to the Boundary Waters was funded through the sale of these cards. Do you currently use the Hy-Vee and County Fair gift cards? If not would you consider doing so? Our youth group gets 5% on every dollar sold. It is a great deal for our kids. The cards are easy to use. Just buy one in the denomination you wish - \$25, \$50, or \$100. When you make your purchase just swipe your card like a credit or debit card and you will be given a receipt with the amount left on the card. You get the full value of the card but our youth get 5%. If you buy gas at Hy-Vee you automatically get 2 cents off per gallon plus their normal 3 cents for a total of 5 cents off per gallon if using a gift card. Cards are sold in the narthex every Sunday. Just look for the person with the blue folder or ask Pastor Schreiner. Our youth group thanks you!
