



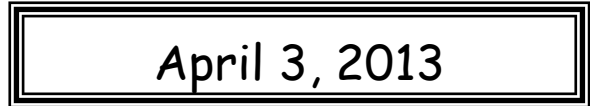
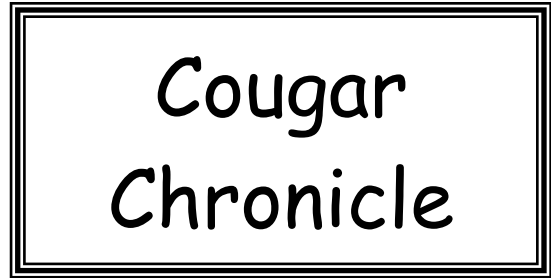

We are excited to announce that Samuel Lutheran School is expanding its Pre-Kindergarten program in the fall of 2013, pending license approval. We will be offering three and four-year-old half-day and full-day programs. A child may be enrolled for only mornings (Tuesday and Thursday mornings for the 3's program; Monday, Wednesday, Friday mornings for the 4's) or you may enroll all day up to five days a week. The center will open at 7:00 a.m. School will start at 8:15 a.m. and end at 11:40 for half-day enrollment or end at 3:00 p.m. for the full day enrollment. The center will remain open until 5:30 p.m. for those that would like to take advantage of the after school program. The center will also accept older children before and after school.
