Monster Bars

stick butter softened
cup brown sugar
cup white sugar
½ cups creamy peanut butter
eggs
tsp vanilla
tsp baking soda
pkg (12oz) chocolate chips
pkg M&M's
½ cups oatmeal (quick oats)

Spray lightly cookie sheet or jelly roll pan. Bake 350 degrees for 15-18 minutes. Do not over bake them, they will look like they are not done when you take them out.
