**Advent Worship:** Our final service will be tonight at 7:00 PM. Our theme is "We Welcome Christ as Prophet, Priest and King". This week we will welcome Christ as our King.

**Children's Christmas Eve Practice:** This Saturday, December 17<sup>th</sup> all of the children (PreK-8) will meet at Samuel from 9:00-10:30 AM to rehearse for the Children's Christmas Eve Service. We will be filling the Christmas bags while the children are in practice. We will do this in the cafeteria. Any help would be appreciated. On Christmas Eve the students need to be at school no later than 5:15 PM.

**No School December 23rd:** There is no school on Friday, December 23rd. School will dismiss on Thursday, December 22nd at 2:20 PM. \*\*Note that due to the early release on Thursday, the 22nd, we will not be releasing early on Wednesday, December 21st.

**Cheerleaders:** The cheerleaders will not have practice on Wednesday, December 21st. Practice will resume on January 11th.

**Visit to the Bakery**: In conjunction with the our study of the story "The Gingerbread Man", the 1<sup>st</sup> year Pre-K visited the Country Fair Bakery. Baker Dan showed us all around the bakery. He was making bread, buns, and gingerbread men. His kitchen was like our kitchens at home in some ways, but many things were different. His oven is very big and the shelves move around in a circle. He has BIG mixers and a freezer you can walk into. He had a red tray that looked like a pizza pan. He put dough on it and lowered a machine onto it. After it shook for a while, he took the tray out and the dough was in little round shapes for buns. He showed us how you decorate cakes and cookies and then he gave each of us a real gingerbread man. It was yummy!

Christmas Worship Schedule: We have numerous chances to worship the newborn Savior this Christmas season. On Christmas Eve our children will lead us in worship at 5:30 PM at Samuel School. The candlelight service will focus on Jesus Christ as the Light of the World. Candles will help us see the "Light of the World" Jesus Christ. This service starts at 10:00 PM at church. Our Christmas Day services will be held at 8 & 10:30 AM. The theme of this service is "Names of Jesus." Looking ahead, we also have services on New Year's Eve at 7:00 PM and New Year's Day at 8 & 10:30 AM.

**Weather Station:** Samuel Lutheran School has its own weather station now. You can access the info on the website for the WeatherUnderground. (You can also find a link on OUR school website under the 6-7-8 grade page.)

Weatherundergound.com Once there you need to **search** for our school station KMNMARSH2 Once there you can scroll down to see graphs of 24 hour data. Right next to the name of our station is "current conditions." That will take you to forecast info and radar. Way at the bottom you can access other weather stations in the area on the weatherundergound.

Also, on the first page for KMNMARSH2...under the map and to the right of the graph, you might like a brief weather page for our station if you click the "full screen rapid fire."

**Spelling Bee:** The spelling word lists have been given to the students so they can begin learning the words. It seems like a long way off, but before you know it, the days and weeks will have slipped by and we will be into January. A lot can be learned by setting aside a little time each day to study spelling. The official spelling bee is only open to grades 5-8, but we will also have a spelling bee for grades 1-4.
