



Advent: Our first midweek advent service is tonight at 7:00 PM. Prior to our worship we will be serving a spaghetti supper from 5:30-6:30 PM.

Child Care During School Vacation: Although the school will be closed from Thursday, December 24 till January 4, Samuel Lutheran Early Childhood Center will only be open for child care December 28-31 (Monday –Thursday).
