Weather Station: Samuel Lutheran School has its own weather station now. You can access the info on the website for the WeatherUnderground. (You can also find a link on OUR school website under the 6-7-8 grade page.)

Weatherundergound.com Once there you need to **search** for our school station KMNMARSH2 Once there you can scroll down to see graphs of 24 hour data. Right next to the name of our station is "current conditions." That will take you to forecast info and radar. Way at the bottom you can access other weather stations in the area on the weatherundergound.

Also, on the first page for KMNMARSH2...under the map and to the right of the graph, you might like a brief weather page for our station if you click the "full screen rapid fire."
