At Christ, we celebrate Ash Wednesday with the Imposition of Ashes. This ancient custom is not just for adults but people of all ages. Both you and your child are invited to come forward for this rite if you so desire. The theme for tonight's service is *Repent: Turn to Jesus and not to yourself*. Prior to the service you are encouraged to attend the Lenten supper from 5:30-6:30 PM in the church basement. Tonight we will be serving hot turkey sandwiches, corn, chips and pickles.
