

Pre-Kindergarten Round-up: Pre-Kindergarten Round-up will be held on Monday, March 21st from 6:00 - 7:30 PM at Samuel Lutheran School. Children that will be 3 or 4 years old by September 1 and are not currently enrolled in our Pre-K program are invited. along with their parents, to join us for a pizza and pop supper followed by an hour of fun. At Samuel, we provide a learning environment with God's Word as the focal point. Reading and math readiness, music, physical development, and listening skills are also an integral part of our program. You may choose to enroll your child mornings (Monday, Wednesday, Friday mornings for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, Tuesday and Thursdays for 1<sup>st</sup> year) or you may enroll all day--up to five days a week. The center will open at 7:00 a.m. School will start at 8:15 a.m. and end at 11:50 for half-day enrollment or end at 3:00 p.m. for the full day enrollment. The center will remain open until 5:30 p.m. for those that would like to take advantage of the after school program.
