Worship Tonight: Please join us for our Lenten worship service tonight at 7:00 PM. This week Pastor Lonquist from Living Water Lutheran (WELS) in Dawson will be our worship leader. We will consider the theme *People of the Passion* focusing on "Nicodemus, the Silent Believer".

*Our youth will be serving supper (lasagna) from 5:30-6:30 PM.

Singing Tonight: Students in grades 3-8 will sing for the Lenten service tonight. We will meet in the church basement at 6:45 PM.

Eighth Grade Confirmation: There will be a meeting for parents of the eighth grade confirmation students on Sunday, April 3rd after the late service.

Pre-Kindergarten Round-up: Pre-K Round-up will be held on Monday, April 4th from 6:00 - 7:00 PM. Children that will be 3 or 4 years old by September 1 and are not currently enrolled in our Pre-K program are invited, along with their parents, to join us for a pizza and pop supper followed by an hour of fun. At Samuel, we provide a learning environment with God's Word as the focal point. Reading and math readiness, music, physical development, and listening skills are also an integral part of our program. Three-year-old children can enroll in a two day per week program, and four-year-old children may enroll in a three day per week program. The classes meet in the morning during the regular school year.
