Friday Fup Day! Friday, October 28th is our next Friday Fup Day! This month's Fun Day is focused on the Reformation. We want to use the week to remember the importance of the work of Martin Luther. The children will work on a special art project during the week that we will display by Friday. There will also be a daily search for information (like Luther had to search the scriptures) that will help each classroom K-8 get clues to a word puzzle. Various other activities and projects will take place in the classrooms. Friday the students will travel the world (as we hope the Gospel can travel the world) in a "Cities" game. We will also have an opportunity to better understand the life of Luther as we eat our lunch on Friday.

LAST KINDERGARTEN TRIP TO HOLMBERG ORCHARD-OCTOBER 5, 2016

We visited Holmberg Orchard as the last part of our books about apples. This will be the last time the Kindergartners can go to Holmberg Orchard because the orchard is going to close at the end of this year. We had our pictures taken by the Holmberg Orchard sign and by the big apple that shows how tall you are. After that, we walked in the orchard. Mrs. Festerling told us that there are more than 7,000 trees that grow 16 different kinds of apples. KINDERGARTEN TRIP TO THE FIRE STATION

On Friday, October 7th, the Kindergarten class visited the Fire Station as part of Fire Safety Week. We talked about the theme for this year "Don't Wait! Check the Date!" This was to remind us to check smoke alarm dates because if they are 10 years old or older, they need to be replaced. We saw a firefighter in his "turn-out gear". He looked and sounded kind of scary but if there is a fire this keeps him safe and he can help you get out safely, too. After that we watched a Sparky video about fire safety. We got to visit the Smokehouse next. We talked about being safe in the kitchen then we went into the smoke room. A firefighter talked to us about "Stay Low and Go" and "Get Out and Stay Out" then we got to practice when the "smoke" filled the room. We even got to practice leaving a room by crawling out the window. Then it was our turn to practice "Stop, Drop, and Roll". We all did a great job. Next we went to see all the fire trucks. They are REALLY BIG! We even got to go into one of the trucks and see some of the tools they use. They showed us the hose tower, too, where they clean and hang the hoses to dry after every fire and we saw the washers and dryers they use to clean their fire-fighting gear. After that it was time to go back to the big room for juice and cookies. While we were having our snack, we were visited by Sparky and Pluggy! Then we got goody bags with fire hats, books, and candy. We had fun and learned a lot!
