Friday Fun Day! Friday is our next *Friday Fun Day!* This month's Fun Day is focused on the Reformation. We have been using this week to remember the importance of the work of Martin Luther. The children have been working on a special art project that we will display by Friday. There has been a daily search for information (like Luther had to search the scriptures) that will help each classroom K-8 get clues to a word puzzle. Various other activities and projects are taking place in the classrooms. Friday the students will travel the world (as we hope the Gospel can travel the world) in a "Cities" game. We will also have an opportunity to better understand the life of Luther as we eat our lunch on Friday.

Reformation Rally/Fall Festival: On Sunday we are going to meet at Samuel for an afternoon of Luther learning – lunch and lecture. From the Nurse's Office Regarding Dispensing Medicine at School: Our school nurse, Mrs. Flock, recommends that parents give Tylenol, cough syrups, cough drops, vitamins, or any other over-the-counter (OTC) medications at home before school, after school, and at bedtime if necessary so the school does not need to become involved. The teachers are not supposed to administer any of these items without doctor's permission. The nurse also suggests mints or lemon drops work as well as the medicated cough drops. Since these are not medicine, teachers could supervise use of these items. If specific circumstances occur where your child needs to take prescribed medicine at times away from home, you would have to contact the school nurse. Mrs. Flock is not in the school every day. She comes in once a week to do paper work and give advice if we have any health questions. Thank you for your cooperation.
