The teachers will also survey the children in the class to find out basic information on how they arrived at school on a particular day. One other part of the information gathering is called a "Walking Audit." I am looking for a parent or two who may be interested in helping with this. What it involves is standing out in front of school and filling in a brief form about the drop-off and pick-up of students at Samuel. Is there good flow, is there any congestion, and are there any problem areas which could create a safety concern.
