**Chapel Mission Offerings for 2010-2011:** The children will be given an opportunity to support two of our area Lutheran high schools this year. We have chosen the two closest high schools, Great Plains Lutheran High School in Watertown, SD, and Minnesota Valley Lutheran High School in New Ulm, MN. These schools provide a Christ-centered secondary education after children leave our Lutheran Elementary Schools after 8<sup>th</sup> grade. These schools begin preparing students for all careers such as lawyers, doctors, teachers, nurses, construction workers, and engineers, but can also help prepare students for service in the church as a pastor or teacher if they would want to go on to MLC or the Seminary. Our first mission collection will go to GPLHS. They have started the year with an enrollment of 122 with 5 foreign exchange students. Something else that makes Great Plains special is the fact that they have a dormitory so students from farther away may also attend. This year there are 72 staying on campus.
