VERSE OF THE DAY: If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.

SERVICE NOTES:

- Come, Holy Ghost, God and Lord: Luther’s adaptation of the 11th century antiphon, Veni, Creator Spiritus.
- First Lesson: God will dwell with his people who turn from their wicked ways and repent.
- Second Lesson: The Holy Spirit, by speaking and breathing, gives the gifts of Christ.
- Gospel: In the midst of most who refused the peace that Jesus came to bring, there is hope among those who hang on his words.
- Lord, To You I Make Confession: In 1653 this hymn was published under the name “For the forgiveness of sins.”
- Triune God, O Be Our Stay: Martin Luther adapted this hymn in 1524 from a medieval pilgrim’s anthem, which was used to ask various saints for help. Luther fixed the text to teach the people to seek help solely from the Holy Trinity.
