**SCHOOL SECURITY PROJECT FUNDRAISING:** At our Voters' Meeting on July 17, the voters approved a motion to move forward with a project to upgrade the locking system of the doors at Samuel Lutheran School. This includes the locking system, the wiring, and a new front door to the entryway. The total cost for the project is estimated at \$41,000. In the motion, \$25,000 was designated from the school gift fund and we are tasked with raising the rest of the money through donations. We have already started raising some of that money and you can see our progress on the school easel in the church's entryway.
