

**VERSE OF THE DAY:** You are my help and my deliverer; do not delay, O my God!

- First Lesson: The Lord promises a prophet like Moses who will come from among his brothers.
- Second Lesson: The Lord's coming brings joy, peace, and thanksgiving.
- Come, O Come, Emmanuel: Drawn from the ancient "O Antiphons," this hymn version was crafted around 12th century. The final antiphon, designated for December 23, is "O Emmanuel, our king and our Lord, the anointed for the nations and their Savior, Come and save us, O Lord our God." An antiphon like this was appointed as an antiphon for the Magnificat in Vespers for each day from December 17 to 23. The first letter of the Latin names for the Messiah spells out the Latin phrase "ero cras" which means "I come tomorrow."
- Creed: Just as John the Baptist confessed freely about the Christ, so our Christian confession always centers on the person and work of Jesus Christ.
- God's Own Child I Gladly Say It: Erdmann Neumeister was a pastor in the early 1700s. He was a firmly-founded Lutheran who wrote and preached extensively against Pietism and other forces seeking to undermine the Gospel in the 17th and 18th centuries. He wrote over 650

hymns, though he is best known for writing the text (libretto) for five cantatas of J.S. Bach. This hymn was written for the 4th Sunday of Advent.

• As Angels Joyed with One Accord: This hymn's original final stanza: Then advents there will be no more/ Nor advent signs for grace in store./ We yearn no more once He has come/ And brought His children singing home.
