

VERSE OF THE DAY: The LORD reigns; he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed; he has put on strength as his belt.

- First Lesson: God promised to David a son who would build God's house and sit on the throne forever.
- Second Lesson: God sent His Son into the world to give us the rights of sons.
- Gospel: Simeon and Anna prophesy concerning the child brought to the temple by Mary and Joseph.
- Let All Together Praise Our God: This hymn was published by Nikolaus Herman in 1560 in a collection of 101 hymns based on the Gospel readings for the entire church year. This was the first of "Three Spiritual Christmas Songs of the newborn child Jesus, for the children in Joachimstal."

• In Peace and Joy I Now Depart: This is Luther's paraphrase hymn on the Song of Simeon. Traditionally, the *Nunc Dimittis* was sung liturgically in the daily prayer office of Compline. Lutherans included it in the Divine Service, singing it at the close of the Lord's Supper. In this way, we confess that in this Sacrament we have seen our salvation with our own eyes and because of the gifts we have here received, we are prepared to depart—from this place or from this life—in the peace of Christ.
