Verse of the Day

The congregation sings this alleluia before and after the proper verse is sung by the minister or soloist.



VERSE OF THE DAY: The powers of the heavens will be shaken, and then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

- The **Advent wreath** marks the passage of the four Sundays in the season of Advent. Each Sunday an additional candle is lit, and the light from the wreath grows increasingly brighter as we near the celebration of the birth of Christ, the light of the world.
- First Lesson: The Day of the Lord will bring destruction to the wicked but healing for those who put their hope in the Lord.
- Second Lesson: Hope comes from patient endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures.
- Gospel: Those who hope in the Lord keep watch and look forward to the day of their redemption.
- **Lo, He Comes with Clouds Descending:** This text by Charles Wesley was originally titled "Thy Kingdom Come" and was designated for the second Sunday in Advent. Stanza three refers to the wounds of Christ, which Jesus bears even after his resurrection (John 20). In Revelation 5, the Lamb at the center of the throne appears "as though

it had been slain." Even in glory, the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross remains the cause of eternal praise.

- **Jesus Came, the Heavens Adoring:** This hymn captures the three-fold Advent of our Lord: Jesus came. Jesus comes. Jesus will come again.
