“TAKE EAT, TAKE DRINK!”: We’re celebrating the Sacrament of the Lord’s Supper today. For reasons based solely upon Scripture we practice “close communion” in our Wisconsin Synod congregations. This has been the standard practice of those church bodies fully committed to the Doctrine of the Real Presence. We would ask that only those members of our Synod or those in complete fellowship with us come forward for the Sacrament. Please speak with our Pastor before the service if you have any questions.

CONCERT: The Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary Chorus will be presenting a sacred concert at our church on Tuesday, March 12th at 7:00 PM. This 50 member choir is made up of men studying to be pastors in our church body. Under the direction of Professor James Tiefel the men will proclaim God’s good news in music, and it does this in a variety of musical styles, old and new. We will also hear instruments; everything from organ and trumpets to piano and guitars. All members as well as our children will have a chance to join them on several numbers.

*Our children in grades K-8 are invited to join the choir in singing a few verses of the hymn “The Church’s One Foundation”. Sunday School children will work on it at Sunday School and those at Samuel during the school day. We think this will be a great and memorable event for our children.

You don’t need to feed them but you will need to get them to Samuel School sometime in the morning (not sure when yet) and they will have breakfast there.
