The congregation sings this alleluia before and after the proper verse is sung by the minister or soloist.

The Christian liturgy is made up of ordinaries and propers. The ordinaries are the parts that stay the same from week to week. These are “ordinarily” the *Kyrie*, *Gloria in excelsis*, *Credo* (Creed), *Sanctus*, and the *Agnus Dei*. The propers are the parts that change each week and are proper to that particular Sunday. Propers include the appointed readings, prayers, psalms, verses, and hymns. The Verse of the Day is a proper. Sometimes, in absence of the proper verse, a general verse may be sung.

SERVICE NOTES:

- The theme of Jesus’ kingship runs through the propers for today.
- “So, then, no one comes into [the kingdom of God] but sinners...He admits no saints but puts all of them out. Whoever wants to be holy He expels from the church. But when sinners come in, they do not remain sinners. He puts His garment over them and says: If you have sinned, I forgive you and your sin and cover it up. It is true that sin is there; but the Lord in this kingdom will not see it but will cover, forgive, and not impute it. So, then, a living saint and member of Christ stands there.” — Martin Luther
- First Lesson: God provided for the man and woman he had created.

- Second Lesson: God provided for mankind, who had become slaves to sin, by the gift of new life in Christ.
- Gospel: Jesus’ compassion leads him to provide food for four thousand.
- Parents: The shorter, oft-repeated expressions in the liturgy are excellent ways for young children to participate in the worship service. Help children watch for and join in phrases like, “Lord, have mercy,” “Amen,” and “Alleluia.”
