**CHRISTIAN WORSHIP 2021: A New WELS Hymnal:** After several years of work, the new WELS hymnal has been completed. Our church council has set a target date of Advent 2022 to transition to this new hymnal. As we begin that process we will gradually implement parts of the new hymnal into our worship services. Starting today, and going forward, our readings and psalms will follow the three year lectionary used in the new hymnal materials. This lectionary is very similar to the current rotation of readings in use. Starting in July the psalm setting (the music which accompanies the scriptural text) will be taken from the new hymnal and we will also begin introducing some of the new hymns. In September, we will begin introducing the new orders of service included in the new hymnal. In the coming weeks information will be available for those who may wish to purchase copies of the new hymnal for use at home or to donate toward the purchase of hymnals for use in our worship services.
