**PASSION HISTORY:** In the language of the Christian church the word, "Passion," (Passion History, Passion of our Lord, Passion of the Christ, etc.) refers to the final days leading up to the death of our Savior, Jesus. The word, "Passion," in this sense comes from the Latin word, "patior," which means, "to suffer." You may not have realized, though, that if you don't attend the mid-week Lenten Vespers services you don't get a chance to really hear the passion history account of your Savior! Those special readings are not read during the Sunday services. How sad it would be to miss out on hearing what Jesus had to endure to save the likes of us! The solution is easy, though...Join us Wednesday evening as we meditate on the great love of God that led him to send Jesus to be our Savior and hear the detailed chronological account of the days leading up to Jesus' death as recorded in the Gospel of Luke. Our services will begin at 7 PM each of the coming Wednesdays and a meal will be served starting at 5:30 PM in the church basement. You're invited to join us for both and we hope to see you there!

**SUPPER:** We hope you will take advantage of the meals offered before every Lenten service. We will be serving soup and sandwiches this week from 5:30-6:30 PM.
