Service Notes:

- This Sunday's historic title is "Cantate" (Sing!) which comes from the opening verse of the Introit from Psalm 98:1: "O Sing unto the Lord a new song, for he has done marvelous things!"
- At the Lamb's High Feast: Originally dating back to some time between the 4th and 9th century, this hymn was designated to be sung at Vespers each evening from Easter to Ascension.
- Dear Christians, One and All, Rejoice: This hymn is Martin Luther's first congregational hymn, written in 1523. The hymn summarizes God's plan to save us entirely by his grace, which includes the sending of the Holy Spirit to guide us into all truth (stanza 9).
- Confirmation is a public profession of the Christian faith, following a period of instruction. In the early Christian church, confirmation was the promise spoken to the newly baptized: "The almighty God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given you the new birth of water and of the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with his grace to life everlasting." Notice the repetition of the same questions asked of the baptized. The baptismal faith once confessed through through sponsors is now repeated by one who has been instructed in this faith, examined, and absolved.
- Gracious Lord, with Love Draw Near: Stephen Starke is a Lutheran pastor who currently serves a congregation in Michigan. Starke is one of the great hymn writers of contemporary Lutheranism. He has called his hymns "rhymed doctrine that is applied to the lives of the people." His hymns seek to clearly teach in an artful way—what the Scriptures themselves teach.
- Take My Life and Let It Be: This hymn was written by Frances Havergal in 1874. The tune was written by her father, nearly thirty years earlier.
