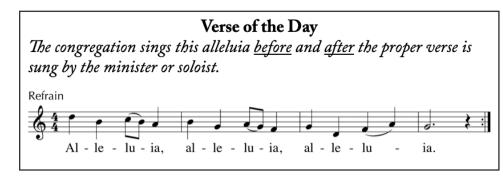

**VERSE OF THE DAY:** They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads.

- Lo, He Comes with Clouds Descending: This hymn by Charles Wesley is set to its traditional English tune, Helmsley. The tune is attributed to Thomas Olivers and is named after a small village in Yorkshire where one of Wesley's closest friends lived and served a parish. Legend says that the tune was based on a snatch of melody Olivers heard someone whistle in the street.
- First Lesson: The Son of Man comes on the clouds to rule and judge all people.
- Second Lesson: The day of judgment comes after great patience, but will come suddenly.
- Gospel: Jesus will come to judge. The verdict will either be a gift of inheritance or the wages of death.
- Day of Wrath, O Day of Mourning: This hymn text and tune comes from a 13th Century Latin hymn, "Dies irae, dies illa." The first line of the hymn comes from Zephaniah 1:15. The 15th stanza of the original refers to today's Gospel: "With thy favored sheep, oh, place me! Nor among the goats abase me, But to thy right hand upraise me."
