

### Luther and Music

One of the greatest blessings God has given to the Church through Luther is the gift of music and song. Luther had a great love for music and the arts. He said, "I am not satisfied with him who despises music, as all fanatics do; for music is an endowment and a gift of God, not a gift of men. It also drives away the devil and makes people cheerful; one forgets all anger, unchasteness, pride, and other vices. I place music next to theology and give it the highest praise. And we see how David and all saints put their pious thoughts into verse, rhyme, and songs, because music reigns in times of peace."

Most of the hymns that we will be using in this service today were written or composed by Dr. Martin Luther. If you are interested in knowing what hymns in Christian Worship Luther had a hand in writing or composing they are listed in the back of the hymnal on pages 939 and 943.

Let your holy angel be with me, that the wicked foe may have no power over me. Amen.

**Congregation:** In the midst of earthly life Snares of death surround us. Who shall help us in the strife Lest the foe confound us? You only, Lord, you only! Save us lest we perish in the bitter pangs of death. Have mercy, O Lord!

**Pastor:** In the midst of death's dark vale Pow'rs of hell o'ertake us. Who will help when they assail, Who secure will make us? You only, Lord, you only! Your heart is moved with tenderness, Pities us in our distress. Holy and righteous God! Holy and mighty God! Holy and all-merciful Savior! Eternal Lord God! Save us from the terror Of the fiery pit of hell. Have mercy, O Lord.

## **The Foundation on Which We Build Grace - Faith - Scripture**

### **First Lesson: “Sola Gratia” By Grace Alone! Trust in God’s Grace to Save**

✠ **Daniel 6:10-12, 16-23**

Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before. Then these men went as a group and found Daniel praying and asking God for help. So they went to the king and spoke to him about his royal decree: "Did you not publish a decree that during the next thirty days anyone who prays to any god or man except to you, O king, would be thrown into the lions' den?" The king answered, "The decree stands—in accordance with the laws of the Medes and Persians, which cannot be repealed." So the king gave the order, and they brought Daniel and threw him into the lions' den. The king said to Daniel, "May your God, whom you serve continually, rescue you!" A stone was brought and placed over the mouth of the den, and the king sealed it with his own signet ring and with the rings of his nobles, so that Daniel's situation might not be changed. Then the king returned to his palace and spent the night without eating and without any entertainment being brought to him. And he could not sleep. At the first light of dawn, the king got up and hurried to the lions' den. When he came near the den, he called to Daniel in an anguished voice, "Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to rescue you from the lions?" Daniel answered, "O king, live forever! My God sent his angel, and he shut the mouths of the lions. They have not hurt me, because I was found innocent in his sight. Nor have I ever done any wrong before you, O king." The king was overjoyed and gave orders to lift Daniel out of the den. And when Daniel was lifted from the den, no wound was found on him, because he had trusted in his God.

## **Second Lesson: “Sola Fide” By Faith Alone!**

### **Faith in Christ Not Works**

#### **✠Galatians 5:1-6**

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. Mark my words! I, Paul, tell you that if you let yourselves be circumcised, Christ will be of no value to you at all. Again I declare to every man who lets himself be circumcised that he is obligated to obey the whole law. You who are trying to be justified by law have been alienated from Christ; you have fallen away from grace. But by faith we eagerly await through the Spirit the righteousness for which we hope. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.

## **The Gospel Lesson: “Sola Scriptura” By Scripture Alone! Use of Scripture Makes Us Wise**

#### **✠Matthew 10:16-23**

“I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. “Be on your guard against men; they will hand you over to the local councils and flog you in their synagogues. On my account you will be brought before governors and kings as witnesses to them and to the Gentiles. But when they arrest you, do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you will be given what to say, for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you. “Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child; children will rebel against their parents and have them put to death. All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved. When you are persecuted in one place, flee to another. I tell you the truth, you will not finish going through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.
