**VERSE OF THE DAY:** Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.

**SERVICE NOTES:**

- First Lesson: God provided food for Elijah and the widow who supplied him.
- Second Lesson: One of the ways God provides for us is through each other.
- Gospel: Your heavenly Father knows what you need and provides for you.
- **What God Ordains Is Always Good:** In the 1670s, Severus Gastorius, cantor (music director) at one of the Lutheran churches in Jena, lay ill when his friend Samuel Radigast visited him and read a poem that he had written. Gastorius was so comforted by the words that when he had recovered, he set them to music and used them frequently with his choir. It was a favorite hymn of Friedrich Wilhelm III of Prussia, who requested that it be sung at his funeral. One of the stanzas omitted from our hymnal sings: *What God ordains is always*

*good: His loving thought attends me; No poison can be in the cup That my physician sends me. My God is true; Each morning new I trust his grace unending, My life to him commending.*

**SINGING TODAY:** We thank the children of Samuel in grades 3-8 for beautifying our worship in song. The hymn they will sing is #529, *Built on the Rock*. It will be sung by the children every week this year at chapel.

**EDUCATION SUNDAY:** Today is Education Sunday. Registration for Sunday School (children 3 years old by September 1 through 8th grade) will take place between services in the basement.
