No School: We will not have school on Friday, May 7. The ECC will be open for any students in preschool or kindergarten who need our services that day. Please reserve your spot with Miss Zander.

Panther Field Day: On Friday, May 7 the 1-8 graders will head to Great Plains Lutheran High School in Watertown, SD for their Field Day. Transportation for this event will work like the Track Meet in past years where parents will be expected to drive their children to the event or work out carpooling with other families. A schedule of events will be attached to the email with the Cougar Chronicle. I'm going to share here what I was told from Mr. Haugly about how the day works since we have not attended one of these in the past. If you have other questions please contact Mr. Obry. Please do note that students should wear their Cougar Shirts or at a minimum a Blue shirt to this day. Finally, another PDF will be attached to the email with the Cougar Chronicle listing meal options from the Junior class at Great Plains.

Mr. Haugly's explanation: Each kid will have a competitor code which will need to be written on their hand indicating their school and grade (Example: S81 = Samuel, 8th grade, 1st on the class list). But that will come later. I will send that out about a week prior and that is your "registration" if you will. The kids can do every event - no limits. So we will have grades 1-4 race in one bowl and 5-8 race in another bowl. We will go in this order: 1st grade girls, 1st grade boys, 2nd grade girls, etc (5th girls, 5th boys, 6th girls, etc. for upper grades) and all those kids would have the option to participate in those races. The relays are next at the same spots. Each relay should be 2 boys and 2 girls as best as is able. The first relay would be 1st and 2nd grade together (5th & 6th in the other bowl). Schools may have multiple teams to give kids an opportunity. The relay race starts and ends at the same spot. R1 and R3 would start on the start/finish line. R2 and R4 would be on the other line 50m (1st-4th grade) or 100 yards (5th-8th grade) away. R1 runs across the field to R2 who runs back to the start/finish line. R3 runs like R1 and R4 brings it home like R2. We have to do it this way since we don't have a track. The upper grades then will have a 400m race. Again 5th girls first all the way up to 8th boys. For field events, both age levels will do one before their lunch break. The other 3 field events will be done after lunch. The order of events for each grade level is on the bottom of the schedule. One note: the upper graders have to choose between high jump or partner races. There is not enough time to do both. Ribbons are distributed after every event immediately. We ribbon out to 5th place. So your kids will accrue ribbons that either a teacher or parent can hold on to. Each ribbon has a label on the backside so adults can mark who they belong to
