MLC is the training college for pastors, teachers, and staff ministers for the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod. It is where Mr. Festerling, Mrs. MacArthur, Mrs. Manian, and Ms. Mays all attended college and they all had a similar student teaching experience that our two student teachers will be doing here at Samuel. Miss Grace Deck will be in Mrs. MacArthur's classroom and Mr. Isaiah Terry will be in Mrs. Manian's classroom. These students are in their Senior years at MLC and their student teaching experience is the culmination of 4-5 years of study in the elementary education program. They will be with us from January 22 through March 29.
