Morning Drop Off/Afternoon Pick Up: We ask that when you drop off your children in the morning that you do not leave your vehicle unattended anywhere in front of the lower building. Since it is a fire lane we need to keep it open for the safety of all. Please also make sure not to leave your vehicle unattended in the bus lane (in front of the steps) as we do have students that ride the bus and this zone is designated for the buses to park to drop off/pick up students. Please park only in designated parking areas which are in front of the upper building or on the north side of the parking lot by the evergreen tree. Finally, please remember to take extra care as you drive through the parking lot and to remind your children to use the sidewalk when walking to the doors in the morning or out to your vehicle in the afternoon.
