Worship Tonight: Please join us for our Ash Wednesday worship service tonight at 7:00 PM. At Christ, we celebrate Ash Wednesday with the Imposition of Ashes. This ancient custom is not just for adults but people of all ages. Both you and your child are invited to come forward for this rite if you so desire. The theme for our Lenten services will be *The Crucial Hours*. Prior to the service you are invited to attend the Lenten soup and sandwich suppers from 5:30-6:30 PM in the church basement.
