Dear parents considering use of Samuel Lutheran's Summer Care:

This letter is being sent to you regarding Samuel Lutheran's Board of Christian Education's decision regarding 2019 summer care. After lengthy discussions at our regular meetings the last couple of months and a special meeting on Sunday, March 17, it was decided at the special meeting yesterday to not have a summer care program for the 2019 summer. While this was a difficult decision to come to, the board wanted to get the decision out to you as soon as possible so you could determine other possibilities for care this summer and they made the decision based on the following:

1. We, at this point, still do not know how the Lord will provide for us in terms of a director position for the preschool. We will be having another call meeting soon, and, if needed, will ask the assignment committee of MLC for a graduate.

2. The low amount of numbers that would be participating in the 2019 summer.

3. With the low amount of numbers and the amount of staff needed to run the summer care due to our licensing through the state of Minnesota we would be having a significant weekly loss that the board did not believe would be wise as stewards of God's blessings here at Samuel.

While we will not be having summer care this year, we are praying and hoping that God will bless us through a director for our preschool as well as in the numbers needing summer care that we will be able to review this program again for the 2020 summer and, God-willing, be able to have summer care next year.
