School Door/Security Project: At the July Voters' Meeting of Christ Lutheran Church, the voters approved a motion to move forward with a project to upgrade the locking system of the doors at Samuel Lutheran School. This includes the locking system, the wiring, and a new front door to the entryway. The total cost for the project is estimated at \$41,000. To date we have raised \$36,439.84 through money that has been given in previous years to a gift fund and through donations that have been given directly towards this project.
