The Marshall Fire Department will be visiting our school on Tuesday, October 11th for fire drills as a part of Operation E.D.I.T.H. On Thursday, October 13th the third grade students will have an opportunity to experience a smoke filled building in a safe environment when they visit a portable smoke house.
