Wind Symphony Concert: Please join the MLC Wind Symphony on Sunday, September 29th at 3:00 PM as we kick off our concert season with "Wind Band Classics!" Featured music on the program includes Howard Hanson's *Chorale and Alleluia*, Sousa's *The Fairest of the Fair*, and Holst's *Second Suite in F for Military Band*. The MLC Wind Symphony is a traditional symphonic band comprised of students from every major and educational track on campus. Its mission is to study and perform representative repertoire for the wind band.
