In order to prepare for that, we are getting more acquainted with the game of soccer through phy-ed and some soccer practices. Pastor Manian will be teaching a few sessions of phy-ed during the end of September and the beginning of October. We are also going to have a couple of soccer practices on Friday, September 27th and on Friday, October 11th with both going from 3:00-5:00. We are in the stages of planning a scrimmage for this fall against St. John's Redwood. Second grade students are welcome to come to the practices but if we have a scrimmage they might not play for their own safety.

If your child is only participating in phy-ed there are no special requirements for them, other than that they have descent phy-ed shoes for running and kicking like any other outdoor activity. If they are interested in joining us for practices and/or the scrimmage they must have shin-guards and socks that are able to cover the shin guards entirely. Having a pair or soccer cleats will help them keep their feet while playing on the grass, but they won't be required at this time. We will have a few soccer balls for them to use, but if your child has their own ball to bring along, that is always helpful. Bringing their own water bottles to practice is also a good idea.
